DESCRIPTION

In Thailand's early morning hours, monks leave their temples to receive morning alms from Buddhists of the local community. Join us on an early-morning trip to Wat Nai Yang and learn about the roots of Thailand's culture from the perspective of its most revered people.

Afterwards, take a journey to explore some of the island's most impressive temples, including Wat Phra Thong, the Chinese Temple at Tha Rua, the Big Buddha and Wat Chalong.



The fresh air, lush rainforest and the sound of gently-flowing water brings you closer to nature, with interesting creatures living amongst the foliage such as flatid planthoppers, oriental garden lizards and even red land crabs.
